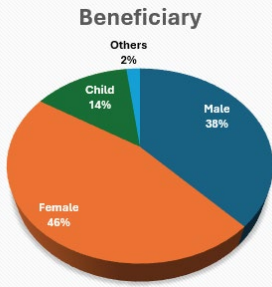


Water well changed their life

Impact Initiative with the generous support of MAA International installed 150 shallow wells in Rangpur, 15 semi-deep wells in Jashore and 30 semi-deep wells in Kushtia to provide clean drinking water.

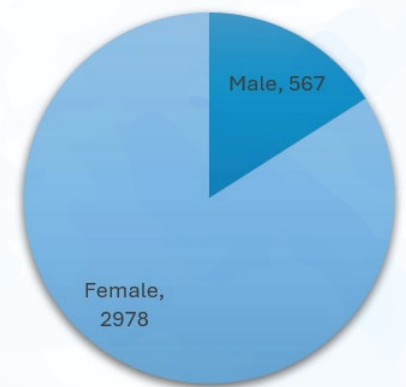


The shallow tube wells, ranging from 150 to 200 feet deep, were set up in various locations throughout the Rangpur district. Meanwhile, semi-deep tube wells, with depths of 250 to 350 feet, were installed in different areas of the Jashore and Kushtia district. This program has benefited over 5500+ impoverished individuals.

Poor people are getting access to medical tests at low cost

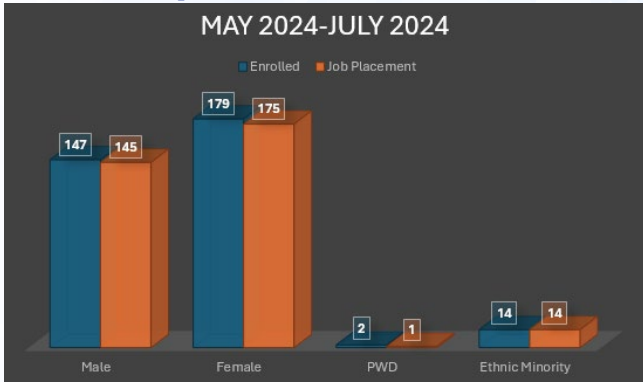


Supported by Impact Initiative and ECHO-USA, free medical services and low-cost medical tests—including ultrasounds, various blood tests, and pathology—are provided at community healthcare centers. From May 2024 to July 2024, the organization conducted programs offering low-cost medical tests, free medical services, free medication distribution, and specialized care for pregnant women.

Skilled manpower is the future of the country



Skill Development is a core program of Impact Initiative, designed to empower entrepreneurs by equipping them with essential skills through targeted training. From May to July 2024, with its own funding and support from ECHO-USA, Impact Initiative trained 300 youth in various skill-based occupations across Chattogram, Rangpur, and Barishal. Impressively, 95% of the program's graduates successfully entered the job market.

Orphaned children are guaranteed quality education and food security

Impact Initiative with the support of MAA International distributed quarterly food packs and Dress to 100 orphans through its Orphan Care Program. These children will be supported up to the age of 18 years of which the 2nd quarter meal is provided from May 2024 to July 2024 in the first year. Each food pack includes regular food items, fruits to meet vitamin needs, and fish and meat to provide essential protein.



Impoverished people got a taste of delicious and nutritious food

Feed the Hungry is a regular program of Impact Initiative. Through this program, 320 poor individuals, including widows, orphans, day laborers, the disabled, and beggars, are served one meal of delicious and nutritious cooked food at each event. From May to July 2024, with support from ECHO-USA, Impact Initiative provided hot meals (Beef Tehari, Egg, Sweet Meat, and Mineral Water) to 1500 poor people in Rangpur, Barishal and the cyclone remal affected area Khulna.



100 cyclone affected families received monthly food aid

In 2024, the coastal area was damaged by the severe cyclone Remal in Bangladesh. Many people's lives and livelihoods are disrupted. Coastal people's houses and businesses are damaged. Extreme food shortages occur in these areas. With the support of ECHO-USA, Impact Initiative provided 1 month of food aid to 100 affected families in the coastal Khulna district.



Poor people were happy to eat the sacrificial meat



Impact Initiative with the support of MAA International distributed Qurban Meat among the poor people of different district in Bangladesh. IMI allocated 25 cows for the Bangladeshi poor community. A total of 1500 families benefitted through this program. They were very happy to get sacrificial meat.

34 cows were sacrificed for the Rohingya Community in Cox's Bazar

Impact Initiative with the support of MAA International and ECHP-USA distributed Qurban Meat among the Rohingya People in Cox's Bazar. IMI allocated 34 cows for the Rohingya people of Camp-4 Extension. A total of 2040 Rohingya families benefitted through this program. They were very happy to get sacrificial meat.
